## **Forum Ground Rules**

- Presenters have signed a pledge that they have read, understand, and will abide by the ground rules.
- Please **refrain from applauding** or in other ways demonstrating support for or opposition to any speaker until the opportunity to applaud at the end of the forum.
- Please turn off cell phones including camera phones. Audience members
  may not use any type of image or sound recording device during the
  forum.
- Only publicly recognized media and Coos Media, in agreement with LWVCC, will be permitted to film or record this event. Coos Media owns their recording and are not obligated to give it to anyone. Recordings must be played in their entirety and may not be used for promotion of an issue. News media may broadcast neutral clips of the event.
- No campaign banners, signs, literature, handouts, or demonstrations are allowed in the forum room. Tables are provided in the lobby for campaign material.
- No visual aids may be displayed during the forum. Presenters may use
  personal notes. Presenters are to turn off any communication devices such as
  laptops and cell phones while on the podium.
- Presenters **will not** engage in personal attacks, will not defame the character of their opponents, and will not deliberately falsify the facts.
- Presenters will remain seated at their places at all times during the forum.
- Presenters may not interrupt one another.
- **Time limits** will be strictly observed. Presenters should stop speaking at the end of the current sentence when out of allotted time.
- Questions, including those which Presenters wish to address to each other, must be written on the forms provided. Pre-written questions will be accepted provided they are anonymous and fit on 1/3-page white paper. During the forum, the League of Women Voters will review all questions to ensure that they are clear, are not duplicates, do not include a personal attack, and address issues relevant to this form. Audience members may raise their hands when they have questions to submit, and a student page will collect them.
- All forms will be destroyed at the end of the forum to protect anonymity.
- The moderator has the authority to enforce time limits, and also to interrupt proceedings to enforce ground rules.
