VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

You **MAY REGISTER** to vote if...

1. You are a citizen of the United States,
2. You will be 18 or older on Election Day, and
3. You are a resident of Oregon.

Registration forms are available at the Coos County Courthouse, North Bend Annex, post offices, the Department of Motor Vehicles, libraries, banks, and city halls. The forms may be filled out and hand delivered or mailed to the County Clerk in the Courthouse in Coquille. First time registration is required at least 21 days before an election. Voter registration updates (changes) may be completed through Election Day. If you are a new registrant in Oregon, identification is required as indicated on the registration card. (See a Voter Registration card for more information.)

Voters may register in a party or may register as “not party affiliated.” Non-party affiliated voters will receive ballots which only include non-partisan positions and measures at the primary election.

Online Voter Registration is available through the Oregon Secretary of State’s website: www.sos.state.or.us

You **MUST RE-REGISTER** if...

1. Your residence or mailing address changes for any reason,
2. Your name changes for any reason, or
3. You wish to change your political affiliation.

NOTE: All Oregon elections are conducted by mail. Ballots are mailed to all registered voters about three weeks before each election. Completed ballots may be mailed in, hand-delivered to the courthouse, or put in designated drop boxes in the county. A schedule of the drop site locations will be inserted with the ballot mailing.

General Election: First Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in EVEN numbered years

Municipal Elections: First Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in EVEN numbered years

Special District Elections: Third Tuesday in May in ODD numbered years

Special Elections: MAY be held on one of the following days, or as set by the Legislature:

1. Second Tuesday in March
2. Third Tuesday in May
3. Third Tuesday in September
4. First Tuesday after the first Monday in November

Electoral Politics Start with the Precinct

The precinct is the “grass roots” of the party political system. Registered voters of the two major parties (Democrat and Republican) elect representatives in each precinct for two-year terms to represent them on the County Central Committees.

Each Committee is composed of one to six men and one to six women from each precinct, depending on the number of registered voters. The Committee elects officers, makes rules for the party in the county, aids candidates, and fills vacancies in the Central Committee. In counties with elective partisan offices, the Committee also nominates candidates for vacancies; however, all county offices in Coos County are nonpartisan.

Any registered voter affiliated with a party may file to run for precinct positions in that party. Citizens can also work for their party by contributing time and/or money, by encouraging qualified people to run for office, and by letting precinct representatives understand how they feel about party organization, platform, and candidates.

The Legislature convenes annually in February at the State Capitol in Salem, but sessions may not exceed 160 days in odd-numbered years and 35 days in even-numbered years. Five-day extensions are allowed by a two-thirds vote in each house. In odd-numbered years, the Legislative Assembly convenes on the second Monday in January to swear-in newly elected officials, elect legislative leaders, adopt rules, organize and appoint committees, and begin introducing bills.

OREGON STATE SENATE

The Oregon Senate consists of 30 members who are elected to serve for four-year terms. Each Senator represents a district of about 114,000 citizens (Census 2000 figures). These district lines are redrawn every ten years. At this time, senators may serve a maximum of two terms.

COMMUNICATING WITH PUBLIC OFFICIALS

The most effective way to convey your views on any issue is with a brief statement of what you think and why. Possibilities for presenting your ideas include:

In Person: You can arrange an appointment during regular business hours. Meetings of governmental bodies in Oregon are open to the public. This includes all work sessions but does not include executive sessions. There are opportunities to speak at most meetings.

By Phone: Brief calls at reasonable hours will be most effective. Because of the time differences, you can call before 8 a.m. Pacific Time for a substantial savings and reach Washington DC during office hours.

E-mail. Because at least 50 percent of all Oregonians access the Internet, most elected officials provide a no-cost opportunity to communicate with them. The Internet is available through local community colleges, libraries, and cyber cafes.

By Letter: The most effective letter will:

- refer to only one issue per letter
- identify a bill by its proper name, content or number
- state your personal position and give reasons for it
- arrive when the issue is current.

Note: Increased security may cause delays for mail addressed to Washington, D.C. We recommend faxing or using local addresses.
